Congratulations! You are the recipient of a Rotary Club of Fort Worth East Scholarship. This scholarship was initiated to encourage and support students from eastside Fort Worth high schools to attend a Tarrant County College campus. As a Rotary Club of Fort Worth East Scholar, you will receive a \$1,500 scholarship for the first year at TCC.

To continue to receive these funds, you must:

- Enroll at TCC as a full-time student, carrying at least 12 credits each semester, and maintain at least a 2.5 cumulative grade point average (GPA);
- Maintain regular contact with your club-assigned mentor each semester; and
- Remain in good standing with TCC, and eligible to continue in classes.

Your award will be disbursed through the TCC Foundation and may be applied to the costs of tuition, books and/or related expenses in the first year.

In the second year, you may be eligible for a matching award provided by the Tarrant County College Foundation, if you meet eligibility requirements. Requirements for second year funding include successful completion of 24 semester hours and a minimum 2.5 cumulative grade point average (GPA).
