Project Description

1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries? Originally the grants aim was to purchase I.V. pumps for the children's ward in the Mexico Medical Missions hospital in Samachique, Chihuahua, Mexico.

A unique circumstance arose that these much needed pumps were donated by a Mexican hospital supply organization .Dr. Michael Berkeley, Hospital CEO, asked our club on February 1, 2016 if this approved grant money, instead be utilized to purchase a used ,modern dental chair and its appliances. The club's board approved this reassignment of the grant funds on February 11, 2016 in a letter to the hospital. This decision was based in part on the fact the I.V. pumps were no longer needed and the dental chair and its appliances was. Additionally this new request fell within the Rotary International Focus of Maternal and Child Health.

The new designation of the grant funds will allow the previous non-functioning dental office to be opened once again. This equipment will service numerous Tatahamuara Indians who need dental services in the future.
