Project Description

The filled back packs were delivered to Esplanade Elementary School in Orange for delivery to worthy students selected by the school administrators on the basis of need.

Four Rotarians shopped for the back packs and school supplies. The entire club (15) formed an assembly line at a club meeting to fill the packs and prepare them for delivery. 3 Rotarians delivered the back packs to the school.
