Dental, vision, hearing and nutrition information was provide to parents and young children in English and Spanish to help them learn how to keep their children healthy. The clinic took place on Feb. 24, 2012 at San Juan Elementary School Multi-purpose room. a. Dental Clinic included general dental screening, filling/extractions, caps, cleaning and referrals for additional services. b. Hearing/vision clinic included hearing screening, vision screening and referrals for additional services. c. Free flu shots d. A CHP officers gave public awareness classes regarding child safety in cars and new laws regarding baby seats e. General health & Wellness Clinic included health screening, immunization check, nutrition and health & wellness information 2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? 16 3. What did they do? The Clinic greatly benefits kids who otherwise would not have basic dental, auditory and vision medical support. For many this is the only medical treatment they will receive for the full year. 6. The Clinic is a collaboration of SJC Rotary Club and the community's 5 elementary schools that sent out the flyers and provide students in need of medical attention. Other organizations that were involved include: a. 50 doctors and USC dental students (USC, AYUDA Dental Clinic) b. 8 students from San Juan Hills High School Interact Club

c. 10 students from San Juan Hills High AVID Clubd. 1 police officer education on child car seats

f. 4 nurses administration a hearing and vision clinic

e. 1 nurse administrating free flu shots
