1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?  
Our Club conducted field trips at Sea Base in Newport for 5 classes from 4 Santa Ana Grade Schools, 2 trips in October'16 and 3 trips in Jan and Feb '17. Students, Rotarians and Teachers spent the day learning about water cycle from rain to garden and bay, pollution thru dumping or pesticides. They learned how to build a sail boat and which sails work better under different conditions. They examined specimens from bay mud for bay and sea creatures and plants etc. It was a great learning and hands on work experience for all. Teachers and Rotarians assisted with all aspects of the project. We received over 60 letters of thanks for Rotary contribution and funding

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? 12 Rotarians and 4 prospects.

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.

Help with cleaning of mud and collection of sea creatures. They also worked on examination of samples under microscope and comparison with available charts and diagrams. Guiding on the trip to Back Bay

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? 240 students and 24 teachers and parents from 4 Schools.

The learning experience obtained by young children and their building of information on life in the bay and ocean, many have never been close to the bay before. Their association of actions taken on land and resulting pollution of the bay and its effect on marine life and cycle of sea life from microorganisms to large mammals.

Trips were conducted by Sea Base of Newport Beach, A Boy scouts organization.


