This project will provide parent resources and baby board books for parents of newborns in BP. On 8/6/16, Acacia Quilt Guild made 110 bags. In November 2016, the Women's Club wove the ribbons into the bag tops so they can be cinched.		
In the meantime, books have been ordered online and they are enrooted to be received.		
2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? Four (4) Rotarians participated in a workshop on Oct. 24, 2016. One Rotarian ordered the books online.

At the workshop, we wrote the District Grant Application. Rotarians participated in the making of the book bags at the Acacia Quilt Guild workshop on August 6, 2016.

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? Newborns in Buena Park and their families will be benefited by the information in the Parent Resource books and the baby board books will promote literacy.
