1. Briefly describe the project. What was or will be done and where did or will the project activities take place? Explain how the beneficiaries and other community members were or will be involved?

The project paid to ship \$265,000 worth of new or slightly used (less than 10 years old) textbooks to the Dawro Education Department, Dawro Zone, Southern Nations, Nationalities and Peoples Region, Ethiopia. There were 196 boxes of English literature, 168 boxes of Science, and 147 boxes of Math for grades 9-12.

- 2. How many Rotarians participated in this project? (estimate if progress report): 1 managing the grant and 81 contributing funds.
- 3. What did or will they do? Please give at least two examples.

One managed the project coordinating with Books For Africa, the Dawro Development Association, and the Dawro Education Department. Approximately 81 Rotarians contributed funds.

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? (estimate if progress report): Up to 158,706 students and teachers.

5. Who are the beneficiaries and what is or will be the expected long-term community impact of this project?

The beneficiaries are the 9-12 grade students (up to 158,706) in the Dawro Zone and their teachers. Long-term community impact is better educational materials (textbooks) resulting in higher quality education for the students.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was their role? Books for Africa provided the textbooks. The Dawro Development Association assisted in getting the textbooks through customs.
