**Project Description**

Food and snacks were provided to low income school students chosen by the Boys & Girls Clubs of Huntington Valley, a 501c3 organization. This was begun in November. We are closing out the grant, as we have met the requirements for the grant, but will continue to fund the project until the end of the school year.
