 - less. Our plan was to drill one+ well in southern Sudan. Due to political unrest, we were uncertain if we could drill safely this year. After careful consideration, we were able to complete the well in addition to many others (20+). Changes included 2 broken drill bits that needed to be replaced; logistical battles to reach the locations; diesel fuel in Sudan was poor quality so had to travel to Uganda to refuel; along with many other dynamic

changes such as labor and living supplies. Luckily the lions were scared away by the

- Provide a brief (100 words or less) of lessons learned in implementing this grant and how this will improve future grant funded projects: It was difficult to tie the current WFS structure to the Rotary Grant structure. WFS will need to better accommodate the administrative changes needed to meet Rotary deadlines. With the drilling season ending in April, most of the receipt, information, etc... had yet to be computed and communicated. For Rotary, the new structure has helped make the grant process easier, but it is difficult to work with orgs that operate under a more cumulative approach rather than project by project.
