Project Description

The Rotary Club of Champions partnered with the Northwest ISD to supply books to be used for in class libraries at Justin Elementary School and W. R. Hatfield Elementary School. We provided checks to the elementary school principals at our December 13, 2017 meeting.

Rotarians worked with Northwest ISD to identify two elementary schools that were interested in a literacy project. After identifying Justin and W.R. Hatfield Elementary Schools, we worked with the principals to help identify age appropriate book selection. We presented checks to the principals and followed up with the ISD to confirm purchase and placement of books.

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?

Improving reading skills and creating a love of reading books for pleasure is the goal of the project. By providing books in each classroom at several reading levels, the children have the means to practice reading. The long term impact of reading programs like this will increase literacy which will lead to more success in school, higher graduation rates and fewer inmates in Texas prisons.
