1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

For the fourth year the Whittier Sunrise Rotary Club has supported the Children's Concerts of the Rio Hondo Symphony. These concerts for 4th and 5th grade students from area schools introduce the young people to classical music and symphony instruments. This supplements their education in ways that the school districts are no longer able to accomplish. This year two concerts were held on January 17 and 18, 2018, at the Vic Lopez Auditorium at Whittier High School.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project?

Members of the Whittier Sunrise Rotary Club were present at both concerts. Six members were present over the two days.

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.

Rotarians assisted with the unloading of the buses that brought students to the concerts and with reloading afterwards. In addition, the club has continued its association with the Symphony Association in which four or more members provide parking direction for the orchestra and handicapped parking lot for each of four regular season symphony concerts. Students from the California High School Interact Club also assist us. These concerts are provided free by the Symphony Association and draw a large crowd with a significant proportion of seniors needing handicapped assistance.

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project?

2,560 students attended.

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?

This is an enhancement to the students' education, the long-term value of which is incalculable. The Whittier Sunrise Rotary Club receives recognition with in the community.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?

The Rio Hondo Symphony Association is the organizer and primary funder of the concerts. Our contribution is directed specifically to the transportation costs so that more students can attend.


