1. What is the purpose of this project?

The purpose of this project is to purchase 8 quick release microphone stands and an Epson Professional quality printer and supplies for The South Orange County School of the Arts (SOCSA) housed at Dana Hills High School. SOCSA is a visual and performing arts academy for students within the Capistrano Unified School District who have special interests and potential for creativity. These items will enable SOCSA to provide help to its 500 students enrolled in the Academy yearly, and additional non-SOCSA students from Dana Hills.

2. How will it meet the needs of the community?

The purchase of this equipment will provide exceptional arts and career training as well as performance opportunities for the students, it will allow them to continue to bring the arts to wider audiences beyond their campus.

This equipment (printer, supplies and microphone stands) will allow SOCSA directly to meet the needs of our community. It will allow SOCSA to reach out. The students will create graphic design for use in print ads, magazine covers, brochures and programs to publicize the shows and community events throughout the year. In this way, SOCSA keeps community awareness. The quick-release microphone stands, will improve SOCSA performers. It will give them the opportunity to deliver higher quality performances at the Porthole Theater and community events at the Dana Point Yacht Club.

The South Orange County School of the Arts (SOCSA) housed at Dana Hills High School, is a visual and performing arts academy for students within the Capistrano Unified School District who have special interests and potential for creativity. It provides students with intensive training in the arts through a diverse art curriculum, offering comprehensive study in the visual arts, dance, musical theatre, acting, directing, theatre history, art history, graphic and commercial art, vocal and instrumental music, and communications.

Students receive individual and group attention from a faculty who have broad artistic competencies and expertise, including guest lecturers, performers, and designers. Over 500 students are enrolled in the Academy, with additional non-SOCSA students from Dana Hills participating in arts-related classes.

The Foundation has recently been investing in opportunities for the Digital Photography and AP Studio Art students to gain career skill experience through large-scale projects such as headshot and event photography services for the performing arts departments, and design projects for Foundation event promotion through online and print media. Students apply their design training to projects that teach important career skills including design pitches to prospective clients and handling time management to meet deadlines.


We are seeking support to allow us to purchase <u>8 microphone stands</u> from Guitar Center that will be used in our theater and for outside performances by our vocal, instrumental and theater departments. We are also seeking to purchase an <u>EPSON Stylus Photo R2880 Inkjet Printer</u>, with paper and ink, to add to our new computer processing lab for our Digital Photography and AP Studio Art students.

The SOCSA Academy is funded by the parent-run SOCSA Foundation; the District provides no funding for the Academy apart from staff salaries. Students are not required to pay tuition to be able to attend SOCSA. All funding comes from parent and community donations though the volunteer efforts of the Foundation parents.

The funding of this equipment will help support our efforts to continue a program of excellence in arts education for our students; the proper resources allow our students to fully explore creative expression through a variety of media, and allow them to refine their skills as artists, laying a foundation for college and beyond.
