## Project Description

- Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries? *3 Keller ISD Interact clubs fundraised in their high schools for Shelterbox, displaying a demo tent for a day and then collecting funds via a "Miracle Minute". These fundraisers took place in February and totaled \$3314. The Rotary Club added additional funds for a total of \$4500 + \$1500 grant; \$6000 was donated to Shelterbox on 4.10.18.*
- How many Rotarians participated in the project? 12+
- What did they do? Please give at least two examples. *Rotarians helped set up/take down a demo tent at each of 3 high schools. A tent was left up for a day for students to see; Rotarians rotated monitoring the tent and supplies during school day.*
- How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? 1000's
- What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?  
*Providing shelter and supplies to a family experiencing displacement from their home has an unmeasurable long term impact on a family's life. Shelterbox supplies help a family survive and ultimately return to a normal life.*
- If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?  
*100+ Interactors were involved in the fundraising for over half of the \$6,000 donated this year. They did a "Miracle Minute" in which spare change was collected during a minute of time during a school period.*
