- 1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries? The project provided dental cleaning, education and dental procedures for 79 patients this year. The USC Dental School, along with Ayuda International (Rotarian Steve Bender) provided approximately 50 dental students and three supervising professors to oversee all dental procedures. The project was held on November 3, 2018 at Niguel Hills Middle School in Laguna Niguel and was the seventh annual free dental clinic sponsored by Laguna Niguel Rotary and the District 5320 Grant.
- 2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? Ten Rotarians participated by procuring breakfast and lunch delivered to the school site for the dental team and Rotarians. The patient sign-in table was staffed by six Rotarians in two sessions. Dr. Mark Montgomery and Dr. William Nguyen, both Rotarians of our club, assisted with patient screening and monitoring dental student procedures throughout the clinic from 8am to 2pm. After the clinic, they also have continued providing pro bono dental care for some young patients with very serious dental decay problems.
- What did they do? Please give at least two examples.
 Two Rotarian Dentists of our club are discussed above in attending to the patients. The others provided check-in of patients and coordinated the breakfast and lunch meals and supplies for the dental team.
- How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project?
 79 student children and some family members were treated with dental hygiene and any necessary dental procedures.
- 5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? This was the seventh year of the free dental clinic. The major impact is to educate children and their families regarding the critical importance of regular dental care to avoid heart disease and a number of other ailments that can originate in the mouth.
- If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?
 As described above, Ayuda International along with the USC School of Dentistry provides the dental services for the children and families.
