1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?  
Robyne's Nest is a Non-Profit which distributes food, toiletries, and clothing to local High School Students who are homeless or at-risk. This Project provided 7 months of Program costs for rental of 900 square feet of office space so that the supplies could be stored and space could be provided for conducting life skills classes to help the students.  
Beneficiaries of this Project are the homeless and at-risk High School Students within the area who are provided with food, clothing, and other needs such as the life skills classes.

Approximately 6 Members participated in the Project.

Three Members participated by delivering food items to seven local schools twice a month. This food was distributed to the students as needed. Three Members participated in a mentoring program.
