They used levels to ensure the poles were plumb (straight up and down) and then bolted them in place. A total of four poles – one at each corner. They will next assist in installing the canopy structure when the weather permits

- 5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? The playground canopy will provide shade throughout the day to approximately 160 youth who use it. The canopy will protect these kids from the UV rays of our hot summer sun. The shade will keep the equipment cooler and allow the children much longer times to be out on this equipment.
- 6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?\_The Boys and Girls Club Board of Directors assisted in pouring the concrete structure needed as the foundation for the vertical support poles.
