1. Description of Projects

Project #1 – Bunkbeds for the Rainbow House (A place for Displaced Children).

We used Work Services Corporation for the cutting and some assembling, they had the equipment needed.

Our club members worked by cutting, sanding, staining and assembling boards to make the beds. This was done in May of 2019.

Project #2 – Dictionaries & Library Books for Scotland Park Elementary.

Members delivered Dictionaries to 3rd graders in October 2018, Library Books in May 2019.

Project #3 – Backpacks for "Communities in Schools".

Items were purchased and donated for the underprivileged kids in our schools. These items were basic needs for hygiene. This was done in May 2019.

Project #4 – End of School Celebration for Scotland Park Elementary Student Council.

These are students that show leadership qualities in an area that's impoverished.

Our Club sponsored and members will attend the celebration at Urban Park Trampoline Center. This will happen on May 18, 2019.

Project #5 – End of School Celebration for "Good Conduct" at Scotland Park Elementary.

These are students that have to show good conduct and keep grades up to attend.

Our Club sponsored and members will attend the celebration at Family Fun **Zone here in Wichita Falls**. This will happen on May 20, 2019.

Project #6 – T-Shirts for Scotland Park Elementary Student Council. These are shirts the students wore to represent the school at different functions. It has the Rotary emblem on the sleeves.

Our Club purchased and delivered them to the students at the school in the December 2018.

Project #7 – Donation to Base Camp Lindsey. This is a project to build housing for homeless Veterans in our community.

Our Club donated funds to help start building a new home. This donation was done in <u>October of 2018</u>. They are in the process of building new homes.

Project #8 – Donation of Basic Supplies to Interfaith Outreach Services. This is where people down on their luck and having trouble with making ends meet go to for help with basic needs and education.

Our Club donated items for basic hygiene. This was done in May 2019.

5. Long Term Community impacts

- Project #1 These children will have a bed to sleep in and will experience a better transition when taken from their homes.
- Project #2 Some of these children have never had a book of their own. The dictionaries meant a lot to them. The library books will be for all the students, this is a school that doesn't get much help with funding from parents.
- Project #3 These are items that will help someone go to interviews for jobs and just

- the overall better health.
- Project #4 This is something these kids don't get to experience very much, it will help enforce that good behavior and leadership will benefit them in the future.
- Project #5 Again, this will show these kids that good conduct and behavior has benefits and will help in the future.
- Project #6 These shirts were for kids that couldn't afford to purchase for themselves.

 They wear them with pride and it also shows that Rotary supports & assists them in their efforts.
- Project #7 This project will help keep veterans off the street, give them and their families a helping hand up to a safer life.
- Project #8 Just the basic needs are sometimes forgotten and not thought about on a daily basis. With these supplies, a person can stay clean and healthier, which means they can also be more successful when applying for jobs.
