GRACE: Replaced items destroyed by a fire; Purchased 3 chrome books for volunteer physicians can "chart" their notes in patient records; Purchased 5 vinyl baskets to transport and sort donated food items; Purchased a specimen refrigerator; Purchased a laptop and projector for education classes. B. Grapevine Fire Department: Purchased 260 life jackets for public use in Grapevine Lake parks to save lives. C. Grapevine Police Department Community Outreach Center: Purchased 2 HP laptops and made much-needed flooring replacements. D. Tarrant County College Scholarships for Hospitality/Culinary Arts/Hotel& Convention Management Students: Scholarships set up for GCISD students and an MOU established so that TCC will match funds for successful students' second year of study. The beneficiaries of all these projects are thousands of area residents, travelers and needy transients.

- 3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples. A joint committee of Rotarians, GCISD faculty and TCC Foundation staff set up the criteria for the scholarships. Grapevine Rotarians helped clean up the mess caused by the fire and helped decide what equipment would be purchased to replace items lost in the fire.
