Arlington North Rotary teamed up with the Lamar High School FIT Program (Families in Transition) which services homeless students and students in transitional housing to help restock their food pantry and clothing closet with shoes, t-shirts, hoodies, pants, leggings, shorts, under wear and socks. Plus, replenish needed school supplies of backpacks, thumb drives, ear buds, pencils, pens and pencil sharpeners, blankets, and supplied feminine hygiene products and laundry soap and a new 3 foot wide X 72 In tall storage cabinet.




