What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries? **WPC helps youth and families lead healthy and lives by providing bi-lingual school-based therapeutic services and access to health resources. Under-age use of alcohol and other drugs (ATOD) is prevalent at San Clemente High School. WPC has targeted their efforts to address this issue and engages parents/guardians, law enforcement, medical professionals and their own staff to that end. San Clemente Rotary with the District was able to fund a month salary for a full time counselor.**

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? **Two**

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples. **Interviewed Executive Director Susan Parmalee. Attended WPC Board meetings. Visited the San Clemente High School campus.**

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? **Approximately 80 teens and their families directly benefitted via counseling. Our funding ensured WPC would continue to be a physical presence on the high school campus, an indirect benefit and symbol the approximately 3,000 students.**

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? **Reduction of ATOD by building community awareness of the risks, symptoms of use, and resources available to address ATOD. Educating a new generation to understand ATOD is not acceptable, cool or healthy so those teens can make appropriate choices.**

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? **San Clemente High School, City of San Clemente, St. Josephs Health, Kaiser Permanente all provide both financial and human resources to WPC. Rotary is proud to be counted among this group of partners.**
