Dear Delia.

We are delighted to report that the Rotary Club of Whittier School Based Oral Health and Nutrition Program activities were completed over 4 days in February and early March of this year.



The expense for the outreach services of our Oral Health Education Program Team total was \$8,211. We greatly appreciate the support from the Rotary Club of Whittier towards these activities. We could not have done it without your generosity, partnership and support.

Our outreach education team was at West Whittier and Longfellow Elementary schools. As usual, it was great to see the smiling faces and talk with the children about good dental health. We could not have done it without our trusted monkey Kirby. He is the star of the short videos we share with the kids.



905 students in 39 classrooms, from TK through 5th grade received Oral Health Education and oral health kits. These kits came in a large reusable zippered bag with toothpaste, toothbrush, floss, timer and oral health information in

English and Spanish. 314 students overall received dental health screenings and fluoride varnish application. This is the best participation percentage rate so far!

Most interesting was that over half of the students returned the permission

slips. This means that their parents saw the form and were aware of this valuable program.



 Attached is the spreadsheet with a detailed list of the number of children served and the results of each day.

Highlights:

- Three children were in need of urgent care referral information and the school liaison will be working with those families to get care ASAP.
- About one hundred were in need of some type of treatment, including apparent cavities that needed fills, and for hygiene services. The other two thirds looked to be in good condition. Every child screened received a list of area dental resources, including the Whittier Assistance League dental program services.
- One room from each school received the Amazon gift card for one hundred percent participation!

All original forms were left at the school site and the health aide will be following up with children in need of treatment. The program was a great success in that <u>all</u> children (and teachers) received the diet and home care training. We especially enjoyed teaching the children in the several special education classes at each school.

This year the Rotarians that came out on the final day to distribute the kits were able to go into each classroom. Each
