Project Description

The idea of the project was to build a long jump pit by July 2014 at Chinook Elementary School. The club has an ongoing relationship with this school. Unfortunately, planning and permitting with the Anchorage School District and the Municipality of Anchorage made it impossible to complete this project before July 2014.

Due to these problems, we reallocated these funds to our Cancer Awareness Truck Project which we completed in September 2014. For this project an active duty fire truck was painted pink to bring awareness to early testing for all cancers. There is also a rotary logo on the truck. See Final Report for project P-540 for more details.
