Project Description

1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries? Purchased freezer for food storage, cabinets for food storage, shelving for clothing closet, and purchased children's playground equipment. This was completed August 30th through September 9th. I Can Still Shines provides food, clothing and counseling to victims of domestic violence and drug abuse. During events that are hosted for the mothers, the children will be able to use the playset while mothers receive their services.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? 3

Two Rotarians selected and purchased the freezer, cabinets and shelving and arranged for delivery and installation. A third Rotarian serves on the board that helped to select the playground set and arrange for delivery and installation. Volunteers of I Can Still Shine installed the cabinets and shelving.

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?

I Can Still Shine expects to reach more than 300 women and children during 2013. The mission is to assist them in becoming self-sufficient and break the cycle of abuse for themselves and their children. They provide food, clothing, counseling, rent, deposits, car repair, gas cards, medical, and eye glasses to those needing a fresh start.

I Can Still Shine is a non-profit organization that is the beneficiary of the donation and will use the items for their mission work.
