- 1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries? Funds used to purchase PPE for multiple locations. This includes the Boys & Girls club of Capistrano Valley and a hospital in Ensenada.
- 2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? Roughly 13 at different stages
- 3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples. Rotarians purchased materials for and assisted with installing plastic barriers for The Boys & Girls club of Capistrano Valley. PPE was purchased complete, and for Mexico was delivered to the border, where the Tijuana club picked up the materials and transported them directly to the hospital. Face shields went to the hospital & the Boys & Girls club.
- 4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? 500 (approximately) This would include the membership and families of the Boys & Girls Club of Capistrano Valley. 200 people who might otherwise have not had face shields, received them. 36 kits of complete PPE as well as other protective gear for hospital front line employees.
- 5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? The project helped get a boys and girls club back up and running sooner, as well as provided desperately needed PPE to reduce transmission in a Mexican hospital for their front line workers.
- 6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? We partnered with the Tijuana Rotary club, the Boys & Girls club of Capistrano Valley. The Boys & Girls club of Capistrano Valley provided expertise & funds to complete the barrier install on their location.
