Report

The intent of this grant was to do the needs assessment for a potential VTT to Bangladesh. Two sites were studied: The Jalalabad Rehabilitation Hospital in Sylhet and the Khulna Rehabilitation Centre in Khulna. This is the report of that journey.

4 persons participated in this analysis: Dr. Craig Hanson from the Hendricks Rehabilitation Hospital in Abilene, Orthotist Raymond Blasingame, PDG Janet Holland, and PDG Paul Geisel.

Findings

The findings are divided for Sylhet and Khulna.

It was a very busy time for each person. Interviews were conducted with the staffs of both hospitals, Rotarians, local officials, University leaders, and medical professionals in each city.

Altogether 17 different Rotary clubs participated.

While the overall purpose was the study it was also a time to visit Rotary projects in Khulna which had been done with district 5790 such as deep water wells.

Sylhet

While our original intent was to organize a VTT it turned out that we became involved in a actual VTT. Dr. Hanson and Mr. Blasingame had the opportunity to see numerous patients and had long sessions with the staff

The Jalalabad Rehabilitation Hospital under the leadership of Dr. Monsural Hogue Choudhury has made great progress since our last visit in 2001. In 2001 there was no professional staff, no elevator, very limited equipment for a 5 story building. Today there is an elevator, a great dedicated staff and a fully functioning building. The following are our collective observations:

1. This is more of an out patient center at this time rather than a hospital.
2. There is still a question of such therapy as needed by some in the medical community.
3. This center might be more effective as a Pediatric center and could cooperate with the adjacent Lions Pediatric Hospital
4. There is a wide variety of clients requiring many different approaches
5. Presently they are not serving many of the very poor although costs are low.
6. Fees are low.
7. Clients receive excellent service over extended periods of time.
8. There is adequate equipment at present.
9. At the present site the hospital is operating at full capacity.

10. There is a need for more connections with local medical schools and hospitals.
11. The Diagnostic process has training needs.
12. Therapists here are able to write prescriptions
13. There is a good number of self-referrals
14. While fees are low the hospital is self supporting
15. Physical layout in the building needs some improvement.
16. Therapy rooms need expansion

Possibilities:

1. Future Interaction with Hendrick to improve the skills of the therapists there to improve diagnostics particularly would be good.
2. It is possible to explore obtaining Peace Corps involvement
3. Bringing a VTT from Bangladesh to be trained at the program at Hardin Simmons University and the Hendricks Rehabilitation Hoapital should be pursued.

Orthotics:

- 1, The present space is adequate but could be expanded some
2. There is a need for some new equipment.
3. Present training by the Jaipur system in India is good.
4. The program now serves only those clients in the hospital.
5. This program has real potential. It needs a new facility, better marketing.
6. The principal issue is that there is no direct contact in the evaluation process.
7. There is little follow up
8. Possibilities for expansion include adding back braces, hand splinting, protheses etc. are real. Present costs of these in local stores are very high.

Possibilities:

The potential for expansion , developing teaching roles and training others for sustainability are the strongest possibilities.

AFTER THE FIRST WEEK IN SYLHET JANET HOLLAND AND PAUL GEISEL PROCEEDED ON TO THE SECOND ROTARY DISTRICT TO THE CITY OF KHULNA.

THE REHABILITATION HOSPITAL THERE WAS VERY SMALL WITH VERY LIMITED ACTIVITY. IT HAD ALMOST NO TREATMENT AREA OR EQUIPMENT. THE PHYSICAL THERAPIST WAS PART TIME AND WAS PRIMARILY DIAGNOSTIC ONLY.

THE FACILITY DID HAVE A PROTHESES PROGRAM. WE OBSERVED A YOUNG LAD AND AN OLDER GENTLEMAN RECEIVE NEW LEGS.

THERE CAN BE NO DOUBT THAT A GOOD DEAL OF WORK MUST BE DONE TO MAKE THIS FACILITY OPERATIONAL.

THE KHULNA MIDTOWN ROTARY HAS A DREAM OF CREATING A COMPLETE HOSPITAL WITH LAND DONATED BY KHULNA UNIVERSITY. A COOPERATIVE PROGRAM INTEGRATING THE COMPREHENSIVE HOSPITAL WITH THE REHABILITATION SERVICES COULD VERY WELL BE POSSIBLE.

IT WAS NOT POSSIBLE TO ASCERTAIN FINANCIAL DATA OR THE DETAILS OF FUTURE PLANS AT THIS TIME. IT WAS APPARENT FROM VISITS TO A NUMBER OF SITES THAT DISTRICT 5790 HAS A SIZABLE PRESENCE THERE. WE LOCATED 13 DEEP WATER WELLS AND 50 WOMEN WITH SEWING MACHINES AND TRAINING THAT HAD BEEN PROVIDED BY OUR DISTRICT. THESE VERY SUCCESSFUL PROJECTS DEMONSTRATE THE ABILITY OF THE LOCAL ROTARIANS TO COMPLETE THE WORK AND TO CONTINUE SUPERVISION.

A FUTURE MEETING WITH PDG SALIM IS PLANNED TO BEGIN WORKING OUT A PLAN AND DETERMINING THE BEST APPROACH.

THIS HOSPITAL IN SYLHET WAS BEGUN IN 1997 AFTER THAT GSE TEAM RETURNED. A RECIPROCAL VISIT THIS NEXT YEAR IS IMPORTANT TO COHTIHUE BUILDING A SUSTAINABLE RELATIONSHIP.

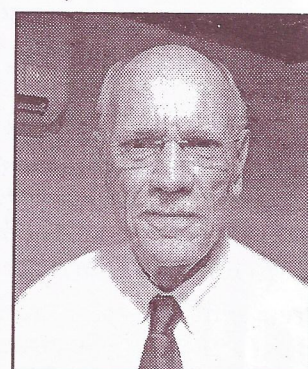


Mayor Mohammad Moniruzzaman Moni handing over artificial limb to the amputee on 13th November at Khulna Rotary Health Complex Building

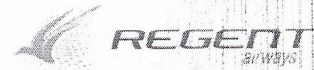

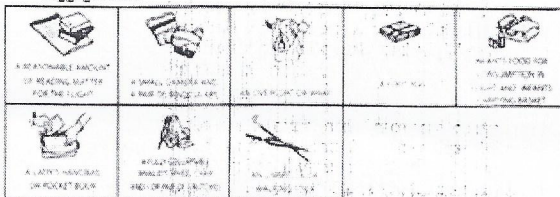

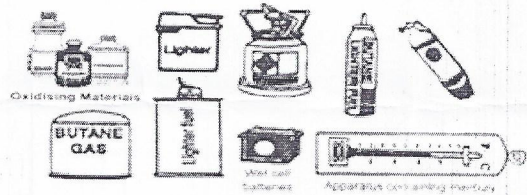


9. RESTRICTED AND DANGEROUS ARTICLES IN BAGGAGE

Present Condition of KU & RDC Hospital

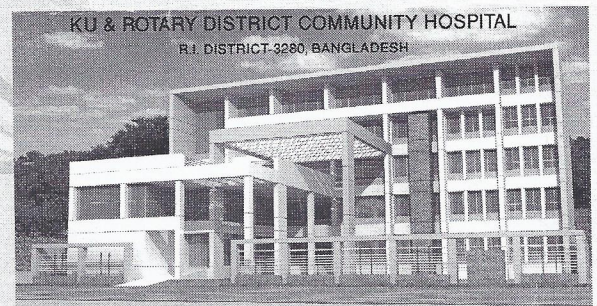
