Project Title: STEM Scholarship to TCC

Project Description

1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

Metroport Rotary partnered with TCC to provide a STEM scholarship at TCC.

There is a continual need for scholarships to help students, especially those from disadvantaged families, to attend college. It is predicted that over 70% of all future jobs in the US will require some higher education and that is even more true in the case of jobs in STEM fields where available jobs will be most prevalent and living wage + productive. This project will fund an established named Rotary named scholarship to provide funding for students on a STEM related career path to attend Tarrant County College, Northeast Campus.

Scholarships will be awarded as students are identified and funding becomes available. It is anticipated that additional funding will be added to this initial amount each year from a variety of sources and the scholarship will continue to be awarded as long as funding is available.
