Project Description

1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries? Funds were provided for the purchase of 20 Chromebooks for R.J. Wilson Elementary for the benefit of the students. The school made the purchase through their district office to ensure the best price, product specifications and efficient registration and set-up. The estimated price was \$335 per Chromebook. We provided \$6,700 (\$1,500 from the district grant and \$5,200 from our club's foundation). Please note, the attached order form and receipt show Rotary funds combined with other school funds to make a larger technology order and purchase for the school.
2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? 3 directly on this project, at least 12 on other projects for the school throughout the year
3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples. Ongoing communication with the school, including a member serving on the School Based Decision Making Council as a result of our Rotary relationship; other projects this year included dictionaries for the 3rd grade; sponsoring 4 assemblies recognizing either attendance or academics; teacher appreciation; and an upcoming bike give away at the end of the school year
4. How many Non-Rotarians participated in the project? only school personnel, approximately 15
5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? Greater exposure to learning opportunities for children who have limited hands-on use of technology outside the classroom.
6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? only the school, as described


