On January 7th, 2022, the San Clemente Sunrise Rotary traveled to Ensenada, Baja, Mexico to assist the Rotario Club of Ensenada with sorting, distribution of blankets, food and soccer balls to those in need in the Ensenada area. We distributed goods to over 1,100 families on the 8th of January. We were joined by the Avalon, Vista and San Diego Rotaries.

All of our club participated in fund raising for the project. 9 from our club joined the others in Baja

We purchased Soccer Balls and took them to Baja. We helped the other Rotarians sort and package the Soccer Balls, Food and Blankets for distribution on Friday night and we distributed them on Saturday.

All of the recipients of our distribution. Over 1,100 people

Warmth from the blankets, relief from hunger with the food and physical fitness with the soccer balls.
