1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries

Emergency hygiene kits for the homeless. Love Placentia was held on Saturday, April 30 at the Champion Sports Complex on Saturday morning. 220 hygiene kits were assembled. The items were placed on two long tables and the volunteers selected a large plastic bag and began placing one of each item in the bag. The items were: a pair of white crew socks, chapstick w/sunscreen, hand sanitizer, toothbrush, toothpaste, granola bar, bottle of water, packet of tissues, one-day bus pass. The assembled kits were delivered to CityNet, a local agency contracting with many North Orange County cities, to assist with the homeless in their community.
