Purchase and distribute Home Care Packages of cleaning supplies and equipment to homeless persons moving from the Friendship Shelter into regular housing.

- 3 Rotarians researched and ordered supplies. Supplies ordered online due to COVID 19 restrictions.
- 2 Rotarians coordinated with Friendship Shelter and housing administration
- COVID 19 delayed and modified presentation to Friendship Shelter to gather together to distribute supplies and equipment.
- Items delivered directly to Friendship Administration Blds and sanitized. Rotarians will present in June at Dana Point location.

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project?

- Approximately 20 Home Care kits were created to support transitional program. Equipment distributed on sign out basis from main facilities per group locations. Grocery gift cares will support over individuals.
- 5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?

Homeless persons who move from the Friendship Shelter into regular housing often find themselves moving into spaces that require an initial clean-up. The getting-started cost of obtaining the supplies and equipment needed, although it might appear to be modest to many of us, can be a real obstacle for those of very limited means. Under the guidance of the staff at the Friendship Shelter, the Rotary Club of Laguna Beach has developed a kit of the most needed supplied and equipment. The kits also contain a grocery store gift care to support the initial stocking-up that everyone faces when moving into a new home. It is hoped that by providing these kits to homeless persons in need, we can help to remove one obstacle to continued success at avoiding homelessness.
