Project Description

1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

GRC provided funds (\$16,700) for the purchase of wheelchairs + spare parts to the RC of Parras, Mexico. They have purchased same + are awaiting arrival so representatives of all RCs involved can go to Parras to distribute the chair. The spare parts will be used to train disadvantaged youths to repair wheelchairs + learn small hand tool skills.

Determined the need for the wheelchairs + wheelchair repair, wrote the grant, funded same + will go to Parras to help distribute chairs. The Parras RC ordered + helped fund the purchase, will organize the distribution + the set up of the vocational training.
