2. Briefly describe your project (who did what, when and where did project activities take place?) in 100 words or less.

The overall project goal was to buy laundry kits for homeless people and families in Pocatello, Idaho. Kits supported 12 loads of laundry with coin operated laundry service "loyalty cards" that operate the washer-dryer machines, detergent pods, fabric softener, and dryer sheets plus a collapsible hamper. The laundry kits were distributed through the Pocatello Aid For Friends Homeless Shelter, the Family Services Alliance that supports domestic violence victims, and homeless children in Pocatello-Chubbuck School District 25 identified by school counselors.

In one brief sentence: who were the beneficiaries of the grant activities and how many of them were there?

Beneficiaries of the project included homeless and indigent people without personal access to laundry equipment and supplies. About 90 people were served during the project year. There are estimated 350 homeless children in the school district.

3. How many Rotarians participated in the project? Briefly tell what did.

About 20 Rotarians from Pocatello Centennial Rotary planned and aided in this project, helped distribute laundry kits and volunteered at the homeless shelter to prepare meals. The project was reported in Idaho State Journal, the community newspaper and social media.
