Project Title: Road to College (RTC) Summer Camp

Project Description

1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

The RTC focuses on the majority of the students the (10% to 90% percentile range of academic achievement. The RTC college program creates a culture of high performance and expectation encouraging the students and their parents/guardians to academically prepare for college. The RTC Summer Camp held at Midwestern State University (MSU) serves about 100 students ranging from 6th grade through 12th grade 2022-2023 academic year. Based on STEM core with emphasis on advanced level reading, mathematics, writing, speech, social skills, and leadership, the program continues to display excellent outcomes with 99% of parents and guardians saying the program should be continued.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? Majority of club membership, 20+

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.

1. Road to College program has been supported since 2015 with RTC joining our flag program drivers to distribute and retrieve flags 12 times/yr (6 holiday periods as well as flag work day). Members rotate driving and other flag service with RTC as a hands on partner. With 300 students in program, we see a few dozen at a time for the dozen plus engagements.
2. Mentoring time with RTC students as well as 4 Way Test Speech Contest and RYLA transportation.
3. Socialize with Picnic and service opportunities

4. How many Non-Rotarians participated in the project? 100+

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?

Increase students graduation with completion of post secondary education, building a more educated workforce while providing visible leadership throughout our community.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?

Cafe con Leche - originator of the program and responsible for recruitment of staff, delivery of cotenct and caching to students. Gonzalo Robles is the founder and has been a SW Rotarian since 2016.
