Wilson Elementary for a Book Vending Machine. The donation was made in October; however, it took until January for the school district to approve the purchase and order the machine. The Book Vending Machine has not been delivered. The purpose of the purchase is to promote literacy in an innovative way, which will benefit the students of Richard J. Wilson for many years.

Wilson for the purpose of organizing various projects throughout the school year. In addition to the district grant/club funded Book Vending Machine, our Rotary Club hosts academic recognition events, distributes dictionaries, hosts a teacher appreciation and does a bike give-away at the end of the school year.

The school outlined these four objectives in making the request: 1) make reading exciting, 2) reward productive habits, 3) strive for literacy for all, and 4) build at home family libraries.
- 6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? Our club worked with the school librarian and principal on the decision to invest in a Book Vending Machine. The school plans to host a ribbon cutting when the Book Vending Machine is in place and operational. Our Rotary Club will be included in that event.
