What was done (in 100 words or less)? *The New Pathways for Youth Rotary Grant allowed 10 students to attend Level Up Academy at a cost of \$500 per student. Level Up Academy is a 10-week course open to students in grades 9-12 and is delivered twice a week as part of the students' regular school day. Level up Academy is an introduction to the skills/mindsets students need to thrive in high school and beyond.*

*This grant project occurred between September 2024 through February 2025 in the Greater Phoenix, Arizona area in the United States of America.*

Who were the beneficiaries? *10 students from underserved youth residing in low-income, high risk Phoenix, Arizona neighborhoods.*


