Education is a key to positive self-image, empowering the student to see opportunities in life, and to avoid being drawn into gang-related activities and life-style.

LOT318 is a non-profit which coordinates the efforts on behalf of the families in these under-served neighborhoods. It provides the student information, and hosts the distribution ceremonies. Some community members contributed towards the purchase of some of the school supplies.
