The Boys & Girls Clubs of Fullerton has partnered with Kaboom to build a new play space at our Teen Center. The Club applied for the project in 2023 and is in final stages of being accepted to build a new play space for our pre-teens and teen members (11-18). There has been an empty space in our outdoor area for several years now, and in an attempt to engage our teen members to be more active we are hoping this new play space can help. Healthy lifestyles a focal point of our 3 priority outcomes for our members, and the benefits of having this additional play space can help our members achieve a healthier lifestyle.

We are partnered with another national non profit, Kaboom, and they source the major funding partner for all Kaboom parks around the country but at this point is unknown to us. The funding partner pays for 90% of the total project cost and we as the recipient of the park must contribute the other 10%

There will be two different ways for the Rotary members to be actively involved with this project. The first opportunity will be in July which is what they call the "Design Day". The other opportunity will be in September which is the "Build Day". On the build days, in conjunction with the professionals hired by Kaboom, we must bring together around 50 volunteers each day to come out and build the entire play space in 1 to 3 days. This would be great way to have local Rotarians to get involved with this project.

Funds will be held by the Rotary Club of Fullerton and will only be dispersed when paid receipts are submitted to us for supplies, soil tests, other necessary items to prepare and build the play area.

There will be a variety of projects/tests that need to be taken place prior to the build of the play space such as; soil test, dig test, removing existing equipment, repairing playground bumpers, and installing drainage if needed. These are just some of the costs/expenses that may be associated with the play space build. Furthermore, here is a more specific list of tools that will be needed for the build.
