Project Title: Get Inspired" - Orange County Ocean Restoration Project

1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?
 "Get Inspired", founded by Marine Biologist Nancy Caruso, is a 501c3 organization with a long-term goal of restoring natural ocean species to our Southern California coastline (Orange County Ocean Restoration). Our club's project is to become involved with this program, at an educational level, by supporting activities for students in the Orange County schools and participating in community outreach events to increase awareness for the public of the critical importance of the coastal ecosystem in all of our lives.

On November 10th, our club supported a hands-on educational event "Art & Nature Festival" at the Laguna Art Museum where we created and manned stations to teach children about the ocean habitat and importance of the ecosystem. We also provided supplies to local high schools to facilitate an educational program in which the students grew sea bass and abalone in the classroom to be released to the ocean.

Beneficiaries: the community of Orange County, the students who are learning and participating in the program (STEM) and, of course, the ocean.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project?

The whole club was involved in selecting activities for children for the "Art & Nature Festival". Several club members helped with the organization of the event and six Rotarians, in addition to 6 Interact students participated in the actual event. The chair of the "Get Inspired" committee worked directly with the founder of the organization to oversee the purchase of supplies needed for the high school's projects.

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.

Rotarians at the educational event sat with children to help with craft activities which taught the children about the ocean and it's inhabitants.

The chair of the "Get Inspired" committee worked directly with the founder of the organization to oversee the purchase of supplies needed for the high school's projects which included building and creating ocean tanks, providing food for the fish, and maintaining a proper habitat to grow the sea bass and abalone.

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project?

Approximately 100 people attended the educational event. Ten high schools in the Orange County area received supplies to grow sea bass and abalone over the course of the school year.

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?

Increased awareness of the importance of the ecosystem of the ocean and the balance of nature, primarily directed to younger children and high school students.
