Will provide and distribute in partnership with Helping Hands Giving Hope 200 Family Thanksgiving Meal Boxes. Which will include fresh vegetables and fruits, canned goods, and a turkey. We actually did 337 boxes and distributed them to ASES funded school sites, City of Lakewood Project Shepard families, LBCC Students, and two church food pantries. These were assembled at the Lakewood Family YMCA.

Assembled and organized the food supplies, event day organization, distribution of food boxes as well as pick up, provided lunches for the 87 volunteers, and arranged for other volunteers. This included Lakewood City Chamber, Lakewood Y Board Members, Soroptimist Club, Mary Star High School, and St. Joesphs High School.

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? 337 families and an additional 58 youth and adult volunteers.

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? To continue to build on number of families served as well as to involve the greater community to provide food and volunteer.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? Helping Hands Giving Hope worked with a local Union to provided resources and R Line (transportation company) to provide pick and deliver of supplies.
