## Project Description

1. Describe the project. What was done, when, and where did project activities take place? If this is a progress report, what remains to be done?

To provide funds for a Rotary Named Scholarship Fund for needy students wanting to pursue a career in one of the STEM fields. Rotarians conducted projects to raise the necessary matching funds for this grant. One club held a "Dancing With the Stars" event in Colleyville in February and the funds were set aside for educational projects. The other club organized a "Golfing for Grads" golf tournament in Grapevine in the spring with all the profit going for scholarships.

2. How many people benefited from this project? 3-5 initially.

3. Who were the beneficiaries, how were they impacted by this project, and what humanitarian need was met?

The beneficiaries will be the students, most of them first in their families to attend college, wanting to enter STEM fields but who need financial help to attend college. Without these scholarships these students would not be able to attain the education they need to support themselves and their families. STEM education is most likely to result in living wage full employment.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?

Tarrant County College signed a MOU with RI D-5790 whereby if a student receiving this Rotary scholarship maintains a required GPA and successfully takes a prescribed minimum of credit hours, TCC will match that scholarship for the second year of education. Effectively this doubles the impact of this grant project and provides two years of education for needy STEM students.


