1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?
 A District Grant of \$1500 was matched with local Club funds to provide two \$1,500 college scholarships to needy high school seniors. The students were Jassmin Del Rio and Ben Salgado, both lower income students enrolled in Breakthrough San Juan Capistrano, a program sponsored by St. Margaret's Episcopal School. This program provides extended year round training and tutoring geared towards lower income students who want to pursue a college education.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? 4

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.
 We established a Scholarship Committee comprised of 4 Rotarians that worked with the Breakthrough Executive Director to (1) develop criteria for application of the funds and then (2) to identify and interview worthy students and solicit applications. That group met several times, reviewed the submitted applications and ultimately selected two students for the award. The students and their parents all attended our April 22, 2015 Rotary meeting where each student gave our club a brief background on their family, their educational goals, etc.

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? 11

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? Our club received tremendous positive press via the attached Breakthrough Newsletter which is sent to an extensive mailing list of prominent people. Both of the students selected also indicated a desire to return to the community following college graduation and work with the Breakthrough program to encourage other younger students.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? Breakthrough and St. Margaret's Episcopal School helped us select a list of students which was review before the final selections were made.
