- Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?
Our project is part of a larger initiative focusing on improving health in the Los Nietos School District area. We have funded the visit of Care Force One, the mobile health clinic of Presbyterian Intercommunity Hospital in Whittier to the three elementary schools of the Los Nietos district. This occurred on October 8, 2014. On this day free Tdap and influenza vaccinations were provided.
- How many Rotarians participated in the project? *Five members of the club assisted the operation of Care Force One over the course of the day.*
- What did they do? Please give at least two examples. *Our club members helped set up the facilities and registered students who were seeking inoculations.*
- How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? *108 students were vaccinated. Parents of these students and other were provided with additional information about infectious diseases and community health facilities.*
- What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? *Reduction in the non-vaccinated proportion of the population and increased health awareness in the community.*
- If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? *The Los Nietos School District and PIH Health are our primary partners in this project. The Hispanic Outreach Taskforce is also a participant.*
