1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

The Newport Sea Base S.T.E.M Based Field Trip Program provided transportation funds for schools and students, the majority for the first time to experience maritime subjects in Life Science, Language Arts, Investigation and History Skills.

The Adaptive Sailing Program now known as California Inclusive Sailing provided therapeutic on the water outings for people with disabilities including Special Olympic athletes, children with Autism, people with spinal cord injury and Parkinson’s Disease. With 47 sailing days completed we served 125 people directly, and built awareness of sailing’s benefits through outreach activities in person and online to over 1000 people.
