6. Challenges

Given that we had over 10 service point, we initially faced registration challenges as everybody wanted to be served first, this was overcome by the organizational abilities of the Rotarians and Rotaractors at the camp. We also ran out of Hepatitis B screening kits and vaccine, this service turned to be the most popular in the community. The exercise cost much more than the amount earmarked for the RFHDs activity, given the numerous services we had to provide. This would have been impossible without the partnership with the Siriba Adopt a village project support.

7. Lessons Learnt

We need to be at the camp site a day before to plan the service arrangements a head of time. We should have done a quick needs assessment to determine services most needed for better preparations.

8. Conclusion

The RFHDs activity in Siriba was a big success. Special thanks go to Opit Kic community group for the mobilization and logistical support to the camp


