- It mainly tends to the needs of the Yaruro-Pumé indigenous children.
- Semi-boarding schools: two weeks at school one week at home.
- It offers five balanced meals a day.
- It offers medical and dental care.
- It is the only educational institution in the area, it is located 40 Km. from the nearest populated center: La Macanilla.
- It offers its students school uniforms and supplies; shoes; clothing; and toys.

Educational model: "New School" (Escuela Nueva) It will see to the education, all the way to high school of around 300 students.

To approximately 900 families that live in La Macanilla Community in Apure.

What do they need?
